A Letter from the Editor

April 1992

After months of watching and waiting for each new version of the Macintosh, I finally bought a computer. I settled on a Mac Classic; its slower than the newer Macintoshes but it still runs System 6.0. Since all my software was made for 6.0 (and not compatible with System 7.0-big mistake, Apple!) it was the best choice.
