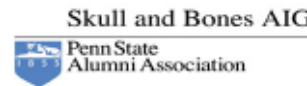

Donation Form to establish the Judy Shepherd & John Lord Trustee Scholarship

The Skull and Bones Society at Penn State has a long history of honoring outstanding individuals for their humble service and leadership to the university and we are excited to share with you a new opportunity we have to support the university.

Our newly proposed Trustee Scholarship will honor two of our youngest deceased members, Judy Shepherd (*Fall 1982*) and John Lord (*Spring 1982*), by creating a Trustee Scholarship in their name. Judy and John were outstanding student leaders and achieved excellence at the start of their careers before passing away in 1993 and 1995 respectively.

The Trustee Scholarship Program, unveiled in July 2002, launches a five-year, \$100 million matching scholarship initiative that partners Penn State supporters with general funds from the University. Unlike other scholarships, contributions to the Trustee Scholarship Program are matched by funds from Penn State, adding 5 percent of the original gift to the spendable income from the endowment. Since the average spending from an endowment is 5 percent of its market value over the preceding three years, the matching will, in effect, double the funds available.

We kicked off the fundraising for this scholarship with a golf tournament on July 11, 2004 at the Penn State Blue Course and will continue raising funds to reach the minimum endowment level of \$50,000.
